Clara, formerly a Resource Coordinator at Transitions-Mental Health Association (TMHA), is sharing a few supportive mental health resources that residents may find helpful—for personal challenges or supporting a loved one. 1. **Friendship Line California** is a free, confidential 24/7 helpline for Californians aged 60+ and adults with disabilities, providing emotional support, friendly conversation, crisis intervention, grief support, and referrals. Call 888-670-1360 anytime (English and Spanish available), through a partnership with the California Department of Aging and Institute on Aging.
2. **Central Coast Hotline** offers 24/7 confidential mental health crisis and suicide prevention support for San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara Counties—call or text 800-783-0607. It's free, with interpreter options for Spanish speakers, staffed by trained professionals ready to listen and connect you to resources.
3. **TMHA Family Support Services** provides free, compassionate support for families, friends, and loved ones of individuals with (or suspected) mental illness. Services are confidential, bilingual (English/Spanish), with separate adult and youth/family tracks—all funded by local behavioral health departments.
